Guardrails (On Purpose)

SempRef operates with explicit boundaries-because trust requires limits.

- Confessional baseline: Westminster Standards

- Sacred representation: avoids generating depictions of the Godhead / divine Persons
- Integrity posture: supports learning and review, not unethical shortcuts
